Regulations and Conditions:

By registering, you agree to the following regulations:

1. Agree to be photographed by photographer &/or news media.
2. Bring your own tables, chairs, etc. None provided. There are no fees for set up or admission.
3. For reenactors, everything visible must be period appropriate during official event hours.
4. Setting up can be on Thursday after 10 am, Friday before 10 am, Saturday before 8:30 am, and Sunday before 9:30 am.
5. Take down after 5 pm Sunday (or after 5 pm on Saturday, if leaving that day). Can camp into Monday.
6. Organization display tables & authors-vendors of historic books: period attire-display encouraged, not mandated.
7. Campfires to be placed in a dug out area and sod replace to original look. Firewood available east of cabin.
8. Use trash barrels near parking lot. Keep the area litter free.
9. No alcohol permitted in this county park. There are many after-hours beverage purveyors in Bowling Green.
10. Cannon & musket firing using guidance of event organizer. Must pick up residue paper, foil, etc.
11. Restroom facility is a lone porta-potty near the paved parking lot (no outside wash sinks).
12. Modern restrooms are in the Museum (hours are 1:00-4:00 and you may be subject to an admission charge).
13. Potable water source is east of oil rig boiler behind small building. A First Aid station will be available.
14. The MVHC, the WCHS, or the WCM are not liable for damages to person, property, or theft
