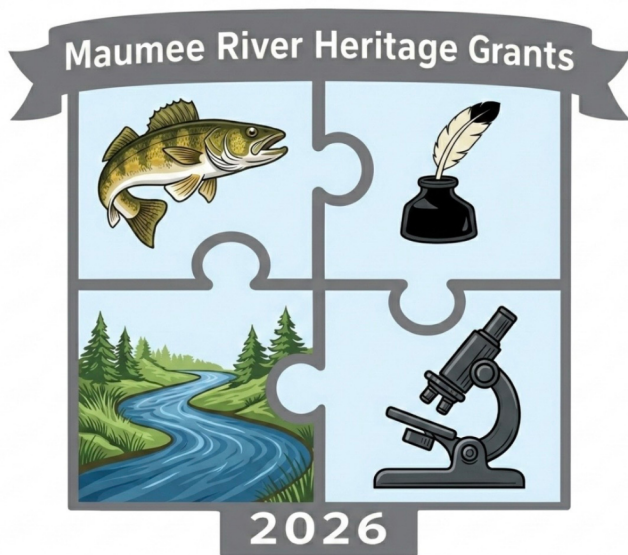
The questions below outline the information applicants will be required to **submit through the MVHC online Google form from March 4 to April 16, 2026**. Please use this information to prepare for the online submission form.

This Maumee River Heritage Grant opportunity is available for those seeking funding for a current America 250 Project or Celebration that is in process currently or will be completed by the end of the calendar year 2026.

If awarded this grant, a brief final report will be required upon completion of the America 250 Project or Celebration.

To be eligible for grant consideration, the Conservation / Research Project must specifically take place along the Maumee River in the following Counties: **Allen County, Indiana, or Paulding, Defiance, Henry, Wood, and Lucas Counties, Ohio**. Location eligibility does not extend to the entire Maumee Valley Watershed.

Eligibility: 501(c)(3) nonprofits or those with a fiscal sponsor. To be eligible for grant consideration, the Conservation / Research Project must specifically take place along the Maumee River in the following Counties: Allen County, Indiana, or Paulding, Defiance, Henry, Wood, and Lucas Counties, Ohio. Location eligibility does not extend to the entire Maumee Valley Watershed.

Eligible Activities: Direct project costs (materials, supplies, outreach, stipends, rentals, etc.).

Ineligible Costs: General operating support, indirect/overhead, and salaries not directly tied to the project.

Match: Not required but encouraged. Can be in-kind or cash.

Reporting: A short summary with photos and budget is due within 30 days of project completion.

Application Deadline: Monday, March 16, 2026, by 5:00 p.m.
Late submissions will not be accepted.
